Offered by the Library and LMXAC:

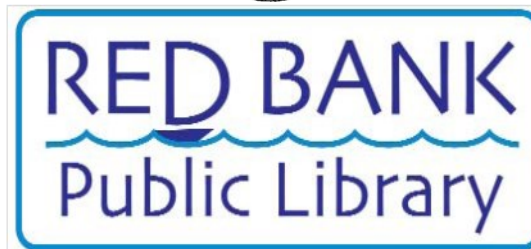
- **Ancestry Library Edition** available only in the library.
