- **RBdigital** Dozens of magazines available for Free download.

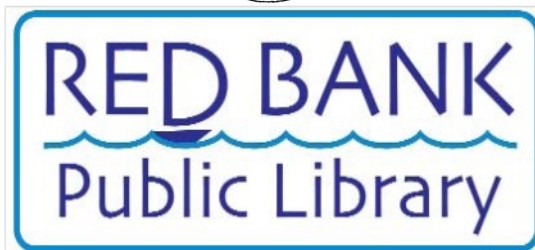
