

Check Out a Public Library Book For Kindle & Kindle Fire

First, create an Amazon.com account. This allows you to download FREE books to your Amazon Kindle and Kindle Fire.

Next, register your Kindle device. Click the pinwheel on the top right corner of your Kindle. Then click “More,” then “My Account” and register your Kindle.



Now, to search and check out books for free:

1. Go to www.redbanklibrary.org
2. Click on “Virtual Branch,” then on “eLibraryNJ.”
3. In the upper right corner, click on “Sign in.”
4. Choose “Libraries of Middlesex Automation Consortium” from the drop-down list.
5. Type in your library card number and PIN.
6. Click “Sign In.”
7. Click “Advanced Search.”
8. Click on “Kindle Books” from the “Formats” field.
9. Include title and/or author information to narrow your search.
10. Choose “Show only copies with titles available.”
11. Click “Search.”
12. To borrow a book, select the title you wish to borrow and click “Borrow.” If the book is not available, you can place a hold.
13. Click on “Go to Checkouts.”
14. Click on “Download,” then choose “Kindle Book.”
15. Click on “Confirm & Download.” This will take you to Amazon.com.
16. Click on “Get Library Book” in the green box on the right.
17. Sign in to your Amazon account.
18. Choose where you would like the eBook delivered (Kindle or computer) and click “Continue.”
19. Click on “Download Now” if you are connected to wifi. The book will appear on the home screen of your device when it is finished downloading.
